2.0 TRAVEL TO THE CONFERENCE

By train – Hereford Train Station, Station Approach, Hereford HR1 1BB. To the venue by vehicle it's 1.3 miles away, approximately an 8 minute cab drive. The shortest cycle route is 1 mile and approximately 7 minutes.

You can book tickets direct from Trainline or National Rail.

We encourage you to join our programme on Wednesday 15th May, which includes a cycle ride around Hereford followed by an evening reception at <u>The Left Bank</u>. Off-peak trains during the day will be considerably cheaper than peak-time trains on the Thursday morning (especially if booked in advance), which will help to off-set the cost of overnight accommodation.

Vehicle route Map – (if travelling by cab from the train station)


Cycle route Map - (if travelling by bike from the train station)
