Waltham Forest council are committed to increasing cycling in their borough. One of the ways they are achieving this is through supporting Bikeability is almost every primary school in the borough — with the aim to be training in every school by the end of this academic year. The council work closely with each primary and secondary school and find solutions to ensure every child is able to take part. The active travel team in Waltham Forest are always keen to try new ways to encourage schools to take part in Bikeability and increase the number of children taking part. This year alone we have provided 3000 children with Bikeability training thanks to the support of Waltham Forest.

For schools who have low levels of cycling ability the council also provide learn to ride and Level 1 Bikeability training to try and ensure that as many children as possible can take part in Level 2 Bikeability training before they begin secondary school. This creates a holistic approach to training which stops non-riders from missing out on taking part in Bikeability.

The team at Waltham Forest are always working to find new and fun ways to engage schools and children in Bikeability training. One of the ways they get lots of children keen to cycle is by running events such as the Tour de Waltham Forest (with a Teen and Mini version running as branches of this). Events such as these get children excited about cycling and offer opportunities for us to involve cycle training in fun ways.
