William Patten School have always been an engaged and exciting school to work with in Hackney. They encourage all of their year 5 and 6 children to take part in Bikeability each year.

This year, the school have pushed themselves further than simply offering their usual courses. They applied for funding through a Clean Air initiative and have used their grant to offer 10 additional weeks of Bikeability training, creating a whole school engagement approach. Every year group has taken part in some form of Bikeability training, from Bikeability Balance for the youngest children through to Level 2 for the eldest.

The Level 2 training was a particular focus, with William Patten being determined to train every single child up to this standard. Despite the additional time and investment this demanded, the school always remained keen to prepare their older children to cycle to school.

Carol, our contact at the school, has been particularly supportive and determined to ensure every child could take part in training. This came despite the many complications that always crop up when organising such a substantial amount of training in one school, such as ensuring we catered to all SEND needs adequately.

Aside from pulling off this impressive stunt through their own initiative of applying for additional funding, William Patten have consistently been a joy to work with, and seeing the results of their efforts has been incredibly rewarding for us as a training provider.
